Call & Caring Meeting: There will be a Call & Caring Team Meeting Tuesday at 6:00 PM. We will meet in the Slagle Room.

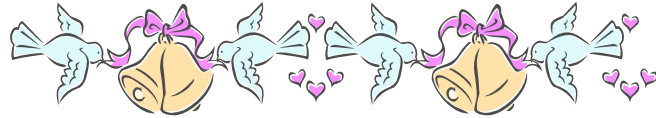
